**ORDER ON PLAINTIFFS' EMERGENCY MOTION FOR TEMPORARY
INJUNCTION**

THIS CAUSE came before the Court for evidentiary hearing on September 8, 2020 and September 10, 2020, on Plaintiffs' Emergency Motion for Temporary Injunction. The Court has reviewed and considered Plaintiffs' Motion, Defendant's Response thereto, the testimony of witnesses and the evidence entered into the record by the Parties, and has heard and considered the arguments of counsel, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises finds that a temporary injunction should be **GRANTED** in this cause. Specifically, the Court finds that:

1. Plaintiffs will suffer immediate and irreparable injury, loss, or damage if an injunction is not granted.
2. Plaintiffs have no adequate remedy at law.
3. Plaintiffs have a substantial likelihood of success on the merits in this action.
4. The threat of injury to the Plaintiffs if an injunction is not granted far outweighs any potential harm to the Defendant from granting an injunction.
5. It is in the public interest to grant an injunction as set forth in this Order.

It is therefore **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that, from the date and time of the entry of this Order and until further order of this Court, Defendant, GAILEN DAVID, is prohibited from directly or indirectly (1) making, posting, publishing, or otherwise disseminating any defamatory or

disparaging statements or communications relating to or concerning Plaintiffs, EN POINTE PRODUCTIONS, LLC, ROBERT LAURIE, NICOLE NOYA, or APRIL CARTER; (2) commenting on any articles or online posts that defame or disparage Plaintiffs, EN POINTE PRODUCTIONS, LLC, ROBERT LAURIE, NICOLE NOYA, or APRIL CARTER; (3) having any contact of any nature or kind with any clients or business affiliates of EN POINTE PRODUCTIONS, LLC.

This Order supersedes all prior orders of this Court and shall remain in full force and effect until further order of the Court. Any violation of this Order shall subject Defendant to contempt proceedings and/or the imposition of sanctions.
